



FUNCTION

The functionality of the room defines its interior space design. Using the available space in an efficient manner is the key to good interior planning. Interior space planning allows you to define a room according to its appropriate function. It ensures that you make maximum use of the available area. It helps to organize your room to serve its intended purpose.

ACTIVITY

Some activities will be obvious - such a cooking in a kitchen or sleeping in a bedroom. It i important to list all the various activities that will take place in each room - such as socializing in an open kitchen, or studying in a built in desk at your bedroom, or watching movies and listening to music in a living area. Once you have a compresnesive list of the ativities in each room your will know how to furnish the room accordingly.



1 Bones (\$120-\$150 per sq ft.)

Plumbing, HVAC, Electrical, hard materials - bringing the space up to code or up to current standards. Your space could be brand new or in need of serious updates. This isn't the most fun portion of your project, but it is arguably the most important.



2 Furniture (\$5000-\$10,000) per room

Upholstery items - Sofas, sectionals, lounge chairs and more. Leather doubles most pricing.

Tables, shelves, bookcases (Built in's are three times the cost). Custom Built in Furniture typically adds about \$150 per sq foot.



(3) Lighting (\$800-\$2000) per room

Decorative lighting, ceiling downlight, ceiling fans with light, table lamps, floor lamps and built in lighting in casework.



(4) Plumbing (\$1000-\$5000) per bathroom

Toilets, sinks, tubs, faucets, and all the accessories



(5) Accessories **(\$800-\$5000)** per room

Art, objects, textiles, Rugs




